Dr. Strain from the Center for Evidence Based Practices in Colorado, has conducted research on peer mediated and inclusive practice for preschoolers with autism for 30 years. His LEAP program has resulted in positive social relationships and results.

Michael Giangreco, Ph.D.

Dr. Giangreco is a Professor at the University of Vermont.
